DON CRUCIFIXTO

Turninu Oloye, known as Don CruciFixto, is a multifaceted Nigerian artist and entrepreneur. He's not only a successful music producer, songwriter, and actor but also a philanthropist deeply committed to charitable work. Don CruciFixto founded Don CruciFixto Entertainment, a media company in the United States, encompassing a record label, artist management, and distribution. His journey into the entertainment world was preceded by filmmaking success and an academic background in Accounting and Information Systems from Bellevue University.

In addition to his artistic pursuits, Don CruciFixto serves as the President of Life In Us, Inc., a nonprofit organization dedicated to improving children's futures. He released his debut album, "MISUNDERSTOOD!" on September 2, 2022, coinciding with his birthday. This remarkable album features 11 tracks that delve into Don CruciFixto's life and emotions, offering a musical journey influenced by legendary artists such as R. Kelly, Michael Jackson, and more. His musical career, which began with his 2021 debut track, continues to evolve with collaborations like "Agba Baller" with Nigerian singer Wetly.

Ghetto Boy, a Grammy-winning Afrobeats artist, rose to fame with his 2017 debut EP "Acainted." His breakout hit, "Under Lover," garnered over 2 million streams and catapulted him to international recognition. Ghetto Boy's collaboration with London Jazztronica duo Blue Lab Beats on "Blow You Away" and his participation in Angelleke Kidjo's Grammy-winning album "Mother Nature" further cemented his reputation. He's performed at major events, including OhMy festival in Amsterdam, and has received awards like Best UK Based Afrobeats Artist and Best Afrobeats Song at the GMA UK awards. Notably, he won a Grammy in 2022 for his contribution to Angelleke Kidjo's "Mother Nature" album and also collaborated with Sean Dampte on the smash single "Go Low."



MAULO

Maulo is a fast-rising UK afrobeats artist and songwriter. With millions of streams already under his belt, and support from tastemakers such as CO, Ntota Magazine, Capital Xtra, and GRM Daily, Maulo is coming into his own as one of the most exciting new afrobeats voices coming out of the UK.

The London artist of Nigerian heritage draws inspiration from afrobeats legends like Wicked Burns, Burna Boy, and Davido, and leans into his penchant for fusing the classic pan-african sounds he has grown up on, with contemporary UK black music to create an infectious afrobeats sound that is quintessentially Maulo.

Previous single "Ambition" was the ring walk song that British boxing sensation Anthony Joshua walked out to in Sept 2021, in front of over 60,000 people. That song, which Maulo created in collaboration with Under Armour, charted at #3 on Shazam across the world, has seen Maulo garner acclaim and rave reviews from the likes of QO, Capital Xtra, Sky Sports, and a feature in the official 2021 3D Sports Christmas Ad.
